The EVE-NG Community Edition (CE) upgrade can be done in two ways. Actual EVE upgrade, or the new EVE V6 installation restoring all data from backup.

- I. Actual EVE CE 5.0.1-24 upgrade to the EVE CE 6.0.1-XX
- Mandatory Prerequisites: Internet and DNS must be reachable from your Server. This upgrade process requires internet access to get updates and install the latest EVE CE version from the EVE-NG repository. DNS must resolve names!
- 1. Upgrade current EVE CE to the latest version 5.0.1-24
- Important NOTE: Make sure all labs/nodes are stopped on your EVE server, and nothing is running on it.
- 1.1. Check your current EVE CE version.

SSH to your EVE CLI as root user and issue: dpkg -l eve-ng This will display your CE EVE current version. It must be version **5.0.1-XX**

1.2. Update your current EVE to the latest version EVE CE 5.0.1-24.

SSH to your EVE CLI as root user and issue following commands:

```
apt update

apt upgrade
  [answer y if required]

apt dist-upgrade
  [answer y if required]

apt autoremove
  [answer y if required]

reboot
```

1.3. Check your updated EVE CE version. It must be 5.0.1-24.

- 2. Upgrade EVE CE to the EVE version 6.0.1-XX
- ▲ Important NOTE: Make sure all labs/nodes are stopped on your EVE server, and nothing is running on it.
- 2.1. Check your current EVE CE version.

SSH to your EVE CLI as root user and issue: dpkg -l eve-ng, It must be version 5.0.1-24

2.2. Start the upgrade with four commands. After the upgrade process is completed, the reboot prompt will appear.

```
UPD=update-eve-ce.sh

wget -O - http://www.eve-ng.net/jammy/$UPD > /tmp/$UPD

chmod +x /tmp/$UPD

/tmp/$UPD
```

```
root@eve-ce5:~# wget -O - http://www.eve-ng.net/jammy/update-eve-ce.sh >
/tmp/update-eve-ce.sh && chmod +x /tmp/update-eve-ce.sh && /tmp/update-eve-
ce.sh

This will launch the Major upgrade to EVE 6.0
Requirements:
- EVE must be up to date ( 5.0.1-24 )
- All Ubuntu packages must be up to date
- External repositories are no supported ( only ubuntu and eve-ng are valids )

If the upgrade process is rejected!

2.3. If your EVE has extra Linux applications and repositories installed, they must be removed before upgrading. Example below is showing that *megacmd* apt is installed.

- 2.4. Extra repo and package removal. (Example, megacmd app)
- 2.4.1. Find the app repo belongs to this apt installation.
- 2.4.2. Remove app repo from your EVE
- 2.4.3. Find the app package name
- 2.4.4. Remove apt, y

- 2.4.5. Complete the steps above if you have other apps installed on your EVE.
- 2.5. Re-run the upgrade script 2.2
- 3. Troubleshooting EVE CE after upgrade
- 3.1. Cannot Login in the Web UI or HTML5 consoles does not work after upgrade. SSH to your EVE CLI as root user and issue:

```
systemctl stop tomcat9
sync
rm -fr /var/lib/tomcat9/webapps/guacamole
sync
systemctl start tomcat9
```



II. New EVE V6 installation with backup restore

- Mandatory Prerequisites: Internet and DNS must be reachable from your Server. This upgrade process requires internet access to get updates and install the latest EVE CE version from the EVE-NG repository. DNS must resolve names!
- 1. Upgrade your current EVE CE to the latest version 5.0.1-24
- ▲ Important NOTE: Make sure all labs/nodes are stopped on your EVE server, and nothing is running on it.
- 1.1. Check your current EVE CE version.

SSH to your EVE CLI as root user and issue: dpkg -l eve-ng This will display your CE EVE current version. It must be version **5.0.1-XX**

1.2. Update your current EVE to the latest version EVE CE 5.0.1-24.

SSH to your EVE CLI as root user and issue following commands:

```
apt update

apt upgrade
    [answer y if required]

apt dist-upgrade
    [answer y if required]

apt autoremove
    [answer y if required]

reboot
```

1.3. Check your updated EVE CE version. Must be 5.0.1-24.

- 2. Upgrade EVE CE backup manager.
- 2.1. Upgrade EVE CE backup manager.
